Dear Families,

For information only: Year 10 and 7 positive Covid Cases at Burton Borough School

I am writing to inform you that we received information of three positive Covid cases at school today – two in year 10 and one in year 7. The year 10 Y half bubble has been closed as a result and some additional students in the year 7 Y half have also been asked to isolate.

As the year 7 covid result was from a rapid lateral flow test (LFT), we are waiting for the PCR (lab test) results to come back. The families of students affected in year 7 have received a letter informing them of the possible isolation dates if the PCR test confirms the positive LFT result.

A number of staff have also been affected by the recent cases and isolating so we will be assessing the situation over the weekend and will inform families if there are any implications in terms of running the school next week. Any communications will be emailed, posted on our website and uploaded onto our Twitter and Instagram accounts (@BurtonBorough).
