Dear Families,

For information only: A Positive COVID Student Case at Burton Borough School.

I am writing to inform you that a student at Burton Borough School has been tested positive for COVID-19 with a PCR test. We worked closely with the Health Protection Hub this morning as soon as we were made aware of the cases and are following guidance from them carefully.

The student who tested positive has been advised that they must self-isolate for 10 days, in line with national guidance. Those who receive a separate letter will need to isolate until the 8th July 2021 (return to school on the 9th July 2021).

I would ask everyone to be mindful of the feelings of the family and student who have tested positive as not only are they recovering from the virus, they also feel a huge sense of guilt on how this will affect those in school who will now also need to self-isolate.

Students who now need to self-isolate will continue their learning on MS Teams.

Telford and Wrekin's Health Protection Hub will be carrying out contact tracing to inform any members of the wider community who may have been in contact with the family, should they need to self-isolate.

From everybody at Burton Borough School, we wish the students who have been tested positive and their family members a speedy recovery.
