


## **Instructions for Registering**




Go to the website and click on register.




Input your personal details and then click get started. You will then be prompted to log in.




If you are a student, click the first option, if you are a parent or carer, click the third option.



Enter the School Name and your year group (you do not need a registration code) then click SUBMIT




In your profile section you will find career related activities. You can also add more details about you and search for career sectors that interest you.




Also in your profile section you have a locker to store documents. This can be things like exam certificates, CV's, work experience records, photographs, achievements, references etc.
