Chetwynd Small School have elected a new Head of the Charity Committee (right). This student will be leading the way to raise money for Chetwynd's chosen charity.

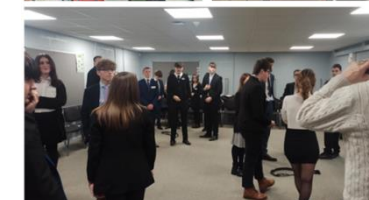

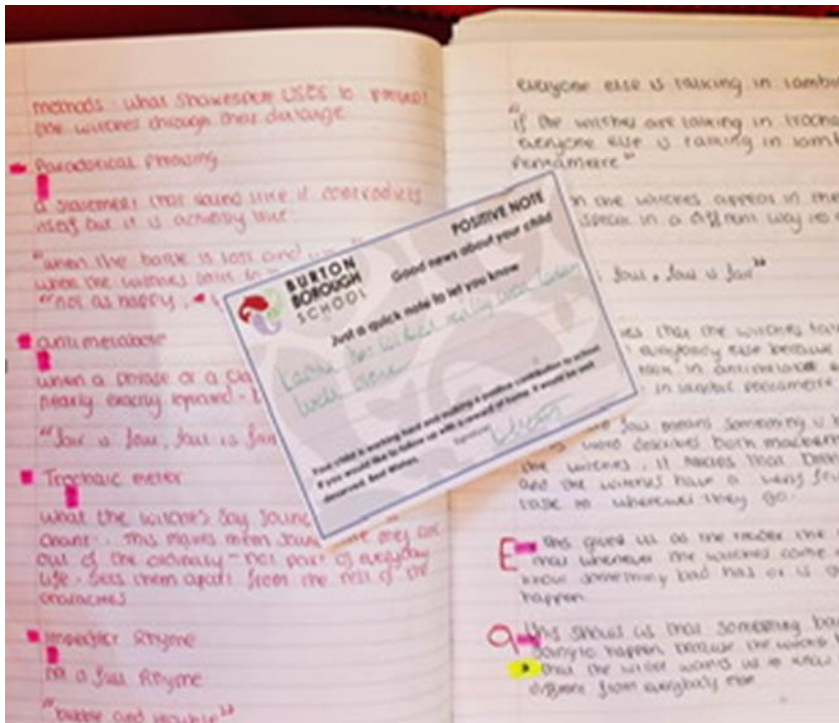
