MFL ideas

At BBS all students have an opportunity to learn a language. We also have other languages on offer in the period x timetable. With that in mind here are a couple of ideas as to how to support our students.

- Duo lingo. This is a free App to download and is wonderful for engaging and allowing students to see words in different contexts. You can even duel as a family to get the most streaks!
- Ask your child to put their mobile phone into the language they are studying. We rarely look at the names of Apps and functions but this will allow them to see it in French/Spanish.
- Watch your favourite film in the language they are studying. It is an option on most film providers to have it in a different language.
- RACAWAC. Primary schools have used this method of repetition to teach their vocab and in KS3 this works really well. Read the word in the foreign language. Cover it up. Write it out and finally Check it (and correct if needed). If you get it wrong do this again until there are no mistakes. You';; be amazed what 15 mins can do.

We have sentence builders that are emailed home and the students use in class and on teams. These are vocab lists split into sections so section 1 vocab is before section 2.




